



CENTRE RULES

YORKSHIRE DALES CENTRE RALLY RULES

1. Any part of a site on which a Rally is held for the exclusive use of the members of the Caravan Club.
2. The Centre Committee reserves the right to refuse the use of the rally site to any member, or to require any member to remove their caravan or motorhome, without being obliged to give reason.
3. The authority for the conduct of the Rally shall be vested in the Rally Marshal or his appointed deputy in his absence, who, in the event of a member breaking these rules, shall be authorized to request such member to remove his caravan or motorhome from the site and, thereupon, the Rally Marshal shall report the matter immediately in writing to the Centre Committee for such action as shall be deemed necessary.
4. All members and visitors must report to the Rally Marshal on arrival at the site. A member must be prepared to substantiate his identity by producing his membership card, if requested to do so, and will be responsible for the behavior of their visitors.
5. Each caravan and towing vehicle or motorhome must be placed on the next available pitch as indicated by the Rally Marshal or his deputy. Then, should the venue allow, the Rallier will be given the option of reserving the next adjacent pitch.
6. Unless previously paid all Rally Fees shall be paid to the Rally Marshal or his deputy on arrival at the site in cash.
7. YDCC DO NOT currently require a non-refundable deposit when booking weekend rallies of 2 nights duration. Payments can be paid in full at the time of booking by click the pay now button on the online booking system. You will then receive BACS payment details by email so that payment can be paid prior to attending the rally. If the pay later option is chosen, then the remaining balance is to be paid upon arrival.
8. *Extended Rally's*
All Rally's 3 nights or over will require payment in full no later than 7 days after booking.
9. At the expiration of the Rally, the members caravan must be removed from the site, unless prior arrangements were made by the Rally Marshal with the site owner.

10. Members must bring their own toilets to all rallies. Toilets must only be emptied at disposal points indicated and must not be charged or rinsed at a drinking water tap. When using communal facilities, it is important to abide by the Covid19 policies in place.

11. Toilet tents and pup tents are allowed on Yorkshire Dales Centre Rallies. Toilet tents are to be erected in the position indicated by the Rally Marshal. A single pup tent, measuring no more than 2 meters by 2 meters, can only be erected within the area normally assigned for a standard caravan awning. Where a porch type awning is erected, a tent may be pitched in the area that would normally be occupied by a full-size awning, provided the tent does not protrude beyond either end of the caravan. The tent must be shielded on all sides with a windbreak, which must be suitably marked for safety reasons with luminous tape. Ralliers should note that the safety and conduct of occupants of the tent is the responsibility always of the person making the booking and should indicate on their rally booking slips if a tent is to be erected.

Any additional

Any part of a site on which a Rally is held shall be for the exclusive use of the members of the Caravan Club The Centre Committee reserves the right to refuse the use of the rally site to any member, or to require any member charges levied by the landowner for the use of the tent must be met by the Rallier. Gazebos may be erected with the permission of the Rally Marshal and must be taken down at night for safety reasons.

12. Open fires and barbecues are not allowed on the Rally Field except by consent of the Rally Marshal.

13. Solid waste and wastewater must be deposited in the receptacles and places provided, or as instructed by the Rally Marshal. Wastewater must not be allowed to discharge onto the ground but must be collected in a container.

14. Speed limit of all vehicles on the Rally Site shall be a maximum of 5 miles per hour. Only fully licensed drivers can drive vehicles on the Rally Site.

15. Animals must always be held or tethered on leads not exceeding 2 meters in length, and when tethered should always be so restricted as to be within 2 meters of the owner's caravan. Animals should be exercised away from the area used for the siting of caravans. Any person may, after due warning of a breach of rule, be asked to leave the site by the Rally Marshal.

16. To obtain a Rally Plaque member will need to book at least 10 days before the Rally commences and ensure that the option for a plaque is ticked on the Online Booking System. Those booking during the 10-day window will NOT receive a plaque even if they tick the box. No Rallier shall be entitled to a Rally Plaque unless they attend the Rally with their caravan or motorhome and is occupied for at least one night.

17. For those who cannot book Rally's Online, bookings can still be made by sending the full fee and booking slip or email with full details to the Rally Secretary and/or the Rally Marshall.

18. All rallies commence at 5 p.m. unless otherwise stated in the brochure, and members must not drive onto the Rally Field before the stated time except by prior arrangement with the Rally Marshal.

19. Noise must always be kept to a reasonable level. Private generators may only be used for a maximum total period of two hours per day, between 10.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. and at no other times.

20. Children under the age of 13 years will not be allowed at socials functions unless accompanied by an adult, who shall always be responsible for their behavior.

21. On account of damage to caravans, flying of kites or model aircraft is not allowed on or over the site, and playing of ball games is only allowed on the portion of the site designated by the Rally Marshal.

22. No responsibility is accepted by the Centre or Rally Marshal for any accident. Members and their families and all visitors attending all Rallies and Functions do so at their own risk.

23. Rally fees may be increased at the discretion of the Committee.

24. Atrocious conditions. In the event of atrocious conditions, a yellow flag will be flown banning movement of all vehicles except with the express permission of the Rally Marshal. Any member requesting towing assistance to move their outfit onto, or off the rally field shall accept that it is at their own risk and accept all liability for loss or damage, and that no such liability shall pass to volunteers giving assistance, The Yorkshire Dales Centre or the landowner.

25. Booking can now be accepted on a rolling basis and there is no opening or closing of booking windows. New rallies will be added to the Booking System when confirmed.

26. These rules are supplementary to the obligation which all members undertake on joining the Club, and which include the observation of the Caravan Code and the Country Code, but in the event of any variance these rules shall apply.
